DETAILED DESCRIPTION AND / SPECIFICATIONS	The Mandela Bay Development Agency (MBDA), a municipal entity of the Nelson Mandela Bay Metropolitan Municipality (NMBMM), hereby invites suitably qualified and experienced service providers to submit proposals for the provision of lift repair, maintenance, and installation services. The primary service location is the Tramways Building. In addition, the MBDA may require services on an ad hoc basis at other MBDA-managed facilities. 1. Site Access and Briefing There will be no formal compulsory briefing session. However, arrangements may be made through on-site security to access and inspect the lift at the Tramways Building prior to submission. 2. CONTRACT PERIOD AND VALUE • Contract Duration: 12 Months • The contract shall terminate automatically upon reaching either: ○ the end of the contract period; or ○ the maximum contract value, whichever occurs first. The successful bidder will be subject to an initial three (3) month probation period. Failure to render satisfactory services during this period may result in termination of the contract. 3. Scope of Work The appointed service provider will be responsible for the provision of lift repair, maintenance, and installation services at the Tramways Building, as well as on an ad hoc basis at other MBDA-managed facilities.

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	Primary Site: - Tramways Building Additional Sites: - Other MBDA-managed facilities, as and when required Important Note: The lift at the Tramways Building is a KONE lift. The service provider may also be required to service lifts of varying makes and models at other MBDA facilities. Service Requirements The service provider shall: - Ensure safe and quality servicing of equipment in compliance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act (Act 85 of 1993) and applicable regulations (GNR. 828 of 17 September 2010, as amended). - Perform planned preventative maintenance to ensure reliability of equipment. - Provide a committed response time in the event of breakdowns. - Maintain effective communication and provide technical assistance. - Respond promptly and timeously to breakdowns. - Render repair and maintenance services on a 24-hour basis, Monday to Saturday.

Technical and Operational Requirements a) Staff Capacity The service provider must ensure that: • A fully trained and qualified Lift Technician or a competent operator (as defined in the Lift, Escalator and Passenger Conveyor Regulations) is available at all times to respond to breakdowns. • Repairs and maintenance are conducted using genuine manufacturer-recommended parts. • All work is supported by appropriate guarantees. b) Maintenance Reporting The appointed service provider will be required to: • Submit monthly service reports, including comprehensive performance statistics • Submit six-monthly load testing reports • Maintain a detailed log/database of all breakdowns and incidents • Meet with the MBDA periodically to review maintenance performance and plans c) Accreditation Requirements Bidders must submit proof of the following: • Registration with the Department of Labour as an Approved Inspection Authority (AIA) • Registration with the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA) for all Lift Inspectors assigned to the contract • Proof of accreditation to repair and maintain KONE lifts
